- **Registration Conditions:**
    - Non-Refundable One–time Registration Fee: \$50
    - Fulltime continuous enrollment waives this fee
    - Camps are two to three weeks long and camps may not be broken up.
  
  - **Camp Tuition Deposit:**
    - Amount of first camp is due April 30<sup>th</sup>
    - If student is withdrawn from any camp after May 1st, tuition is forfeited
  
  - **Refund/Withdrawal Conditions:**
    - All written refund requests must be made before May 1<sup>st</sup>
    - No refunds given after May 1<sup>st</sup>
    - Missed days at camp are non-refundable
  
  - **Camp Billing:**
    - Full tuition due **before** 1st of the month preceding camps
    - Tuition received after the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month results in a \$25 late fee
  
  - **Camp Hours:**
    - Camp hours are from 9am – 3pm
    - Additional time for part-time and school day campers is \$20 per hour (billed in half hour increments)

## Get Moving & Sports Camp



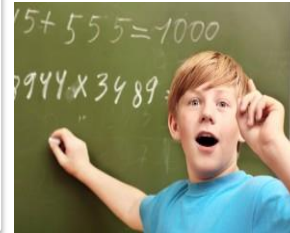
July 30<sup>th</sup> – August 23<sup>rd</sup>
